## **Policy Statement**

In order to be admitted into an undergraduate degree program, a student must possess a minimum 2.0 high school GPA.

## **Policy Procedures**

The prospective student should complete the following steps:

- 1. Submit a complete application online at <u>carolinau.edu</u>. The application should be accompanied by the application fee which can be submitted via web instructions.
- 2. Request official transcripts from high school and any other college(s) attended to be mailed or submitted via secure electronic transfer by the institutions to the CU Office of Admissions.

Note: Although standardized test scores (SAT/ACT) are not required for admission to the university, there are cases in which a student may benefit by submitting scores. These include Academic Scholarship evaluation and athletic eligibility. It is within the applicant's discretion to determine whether it is necessary to submit scores.
