TRACS REAFFIRMATION

Since 1994 Piedmont has held accreditation through the Transnational Association of Christian Colleges and Schools (TRACS). TRACS is authorized by the U.S. Department of Education to evaluate institutions on a number of national educational norms. In 2019-2020, PIU will go through the process of reaffirmation, a task which is too great for any one office to handle. Sub-committees will be formed to complete the tasks of conducting research, preparing a narrative to submit to TRACS, and determining whether PIU is in compliance with the TRACS standards.

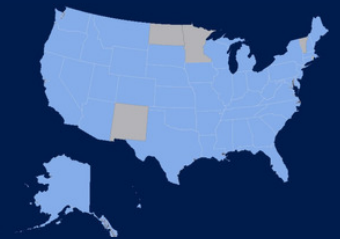

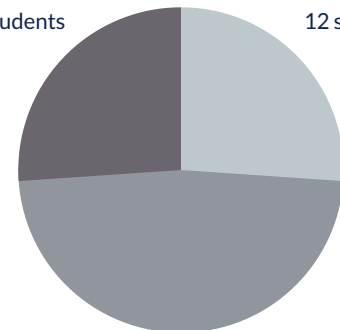
