 - Please provide 2 letters from a professional third party (not a friend or relative) to corroborate your situation. Professional references include but are not limited to, Clergy, Mental Health Counselor, Teacher, Guidance Counselor, Coach, etc.

- Self-supporting
- At risk of homelessness
 - Attach a letter which states that you are unaccompanied and homeless or unaccompanied, self-supporting, and at risk of homelessness from either of the following:
 - Your high school or school district homeless liaison,
 - The director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program
 - The director of a runaway or homeless youth basic shelter or transitional living program
 - Another relevant third-party professional (such as mental health professionals, social workers, mentors, doctors, clergy, and college or high school counselors).
